Only daughter of Max Radin 1880 - 1950 and Rose Jaffe 1889 - 1918.

Rhea Radin, 81, a retired Washington DC real estate broker, died Oct., 29 1991 at Holy Cross Hospital in Fort Lauderdale, fL, after an operation for an embolism.

Miss Radin was born in New York City. She graduated from the University of California at Berkeley and did postgraduate study in psychiatric social work at the University of Chicago for 2 years before moving to Washington DC during World War II.

After the war she was an administrator in Washington and London with the United Nations Relief and Rehabilitation Administration, specializing in displaced persons. She returned to Washington in 1947 and worked until the mid-1950's as an administrator with a predecessor agency of the Dept of Health and Human Services.

In 1957, she opened a real estate brokerage, Rhea Raden Real Estate Inc., in Foggy Bottom. She moved the business to Capitol Hill about 1960. About 1989 she closed the business and moved to Fort Lauderdale. There are no immediate survivors. Washington Post Nov 2, 1991 C6

Working for Rhea on the Hill just before she moved to FL was an eye opening experience for a young college student. She was outspoken, a trailblazing business woman, and held her own against ALL odds for decades. She often & lovingly spoke of her father, Max Radin 1880-1950.
